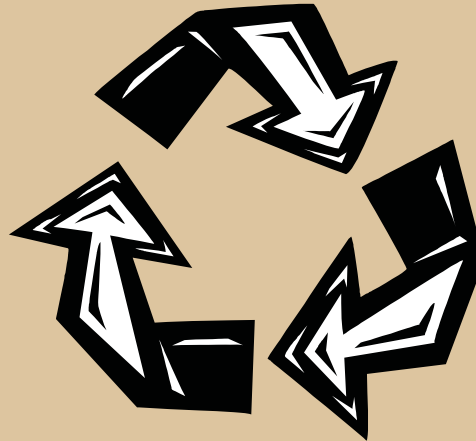


## Mercury recycling helps you comply with regulations—and save the environment

EDI offers a recycling program to help ensure that the fluorescent lamps and lighting ballasts, we sell get processed appropriately. “We want to do our part to keep mercury and other hazardous substances out of our drinking water and the general waste stream.” said Chris Studney, EDI’s manager of business development.

While mercury is one of the most useful of the heavy metals used in our daily lives, it is also one of the most deadly—especially when carelessly handled or improperly disposed of.

EDI’s recycling program helps customers comply with EPA enforcement of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act and the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, which regulate



the disposal of hazardous wastes. Companies that do not comply with these regulations are at risk of severe financial penalties, criminal prosecution, and long-term liability.

The recycling service is simple and turnkey. When you place a recycling order with us, you’ll receive a container with a prepaid UPS shipping label attached. Pack the box with items to be recycled and give it to your local UPS

driver. When the box arrives at the recycling center, it will be scanned to record that your shipment has arrived. You can track your shipment and print proof-of-recycling certificates.

EDI’s program is an ideal recycling solution for many of our customers, including commercial contractors, property management companies, and contractors handling retrofit projects. However, all of our customers can benefit from this program and are encouraged to use it.
